About us

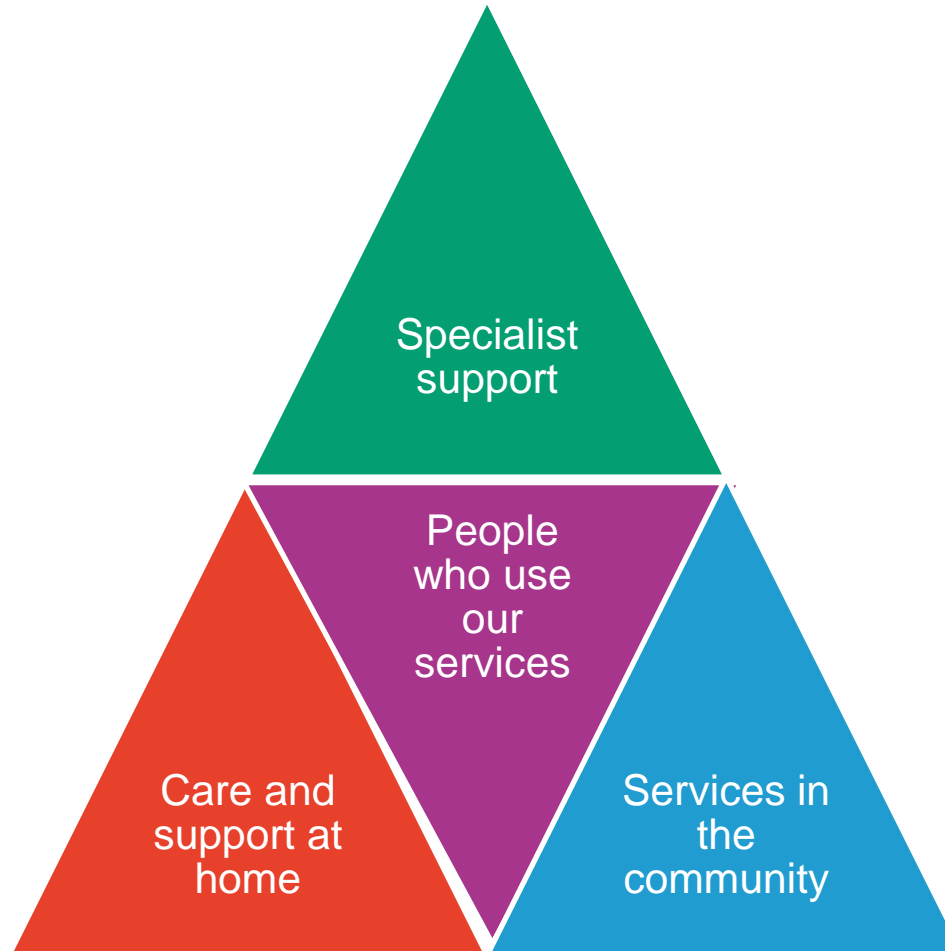
We are a national charity who have been helping people with care and support needs, and their carers, to lead independent and fulfilling lives for nearly 35 years.

Mary's Shoes – Doncaster Admiral Service

- Multi disciplinary family support service for those with Dementia and their families
- 6 partners; Making Space (host organisation) Age UK, Alzheimer's Society, Doncaster CCG, Dementia UK, NHS Trust (RDaSH)
- Pilot for 14 months
- 3 Admiral Nurses and 6 Dementia Navigators

Carol's shoes – Dementia Law Clinic

Carol's mother was diagnosed with dementia three years ago and was initially looked after by her dad, who was her main carer until he passed away in 2014. Her mother's health deteriorated following his death which necessitated her going into residential care.

As her mum's appointee, Carol is officially recognised as being able to manage her mum's financial affairs.

However, when Carol went to the bank about getting a card in her name for her mum's account, she was shocked to find the bank didn't know what being an appointee meant

Confused and at a standstill, Carol reached out to the Dementia Law Clinic at Making Space.

Dawn's shoes – Partnership working

- Contour Housing wanted to become more Dementia friendly
- Developed 5 Dementia cafés
- Mentored and developed employees
- Worked with local communities to create Dementia friendly communities



Dawn's Shoes – Partnership working



Contour Housing wanted to create Dementia friendly environments. They commissioned Making Space to develop this, starting with 3 schemes which has since doubled.
