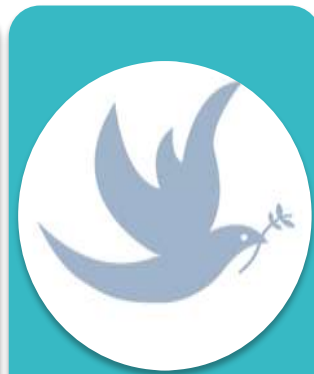

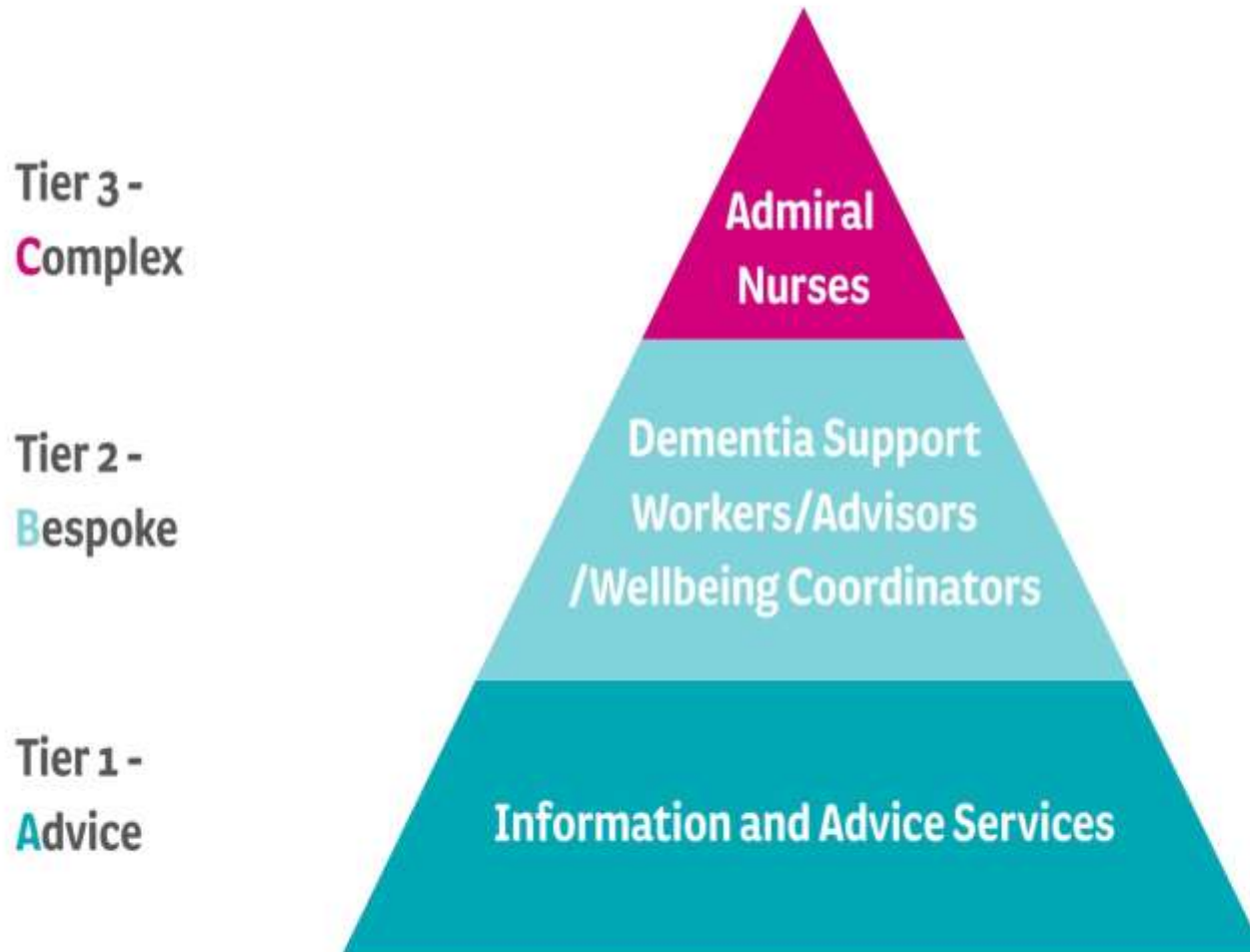

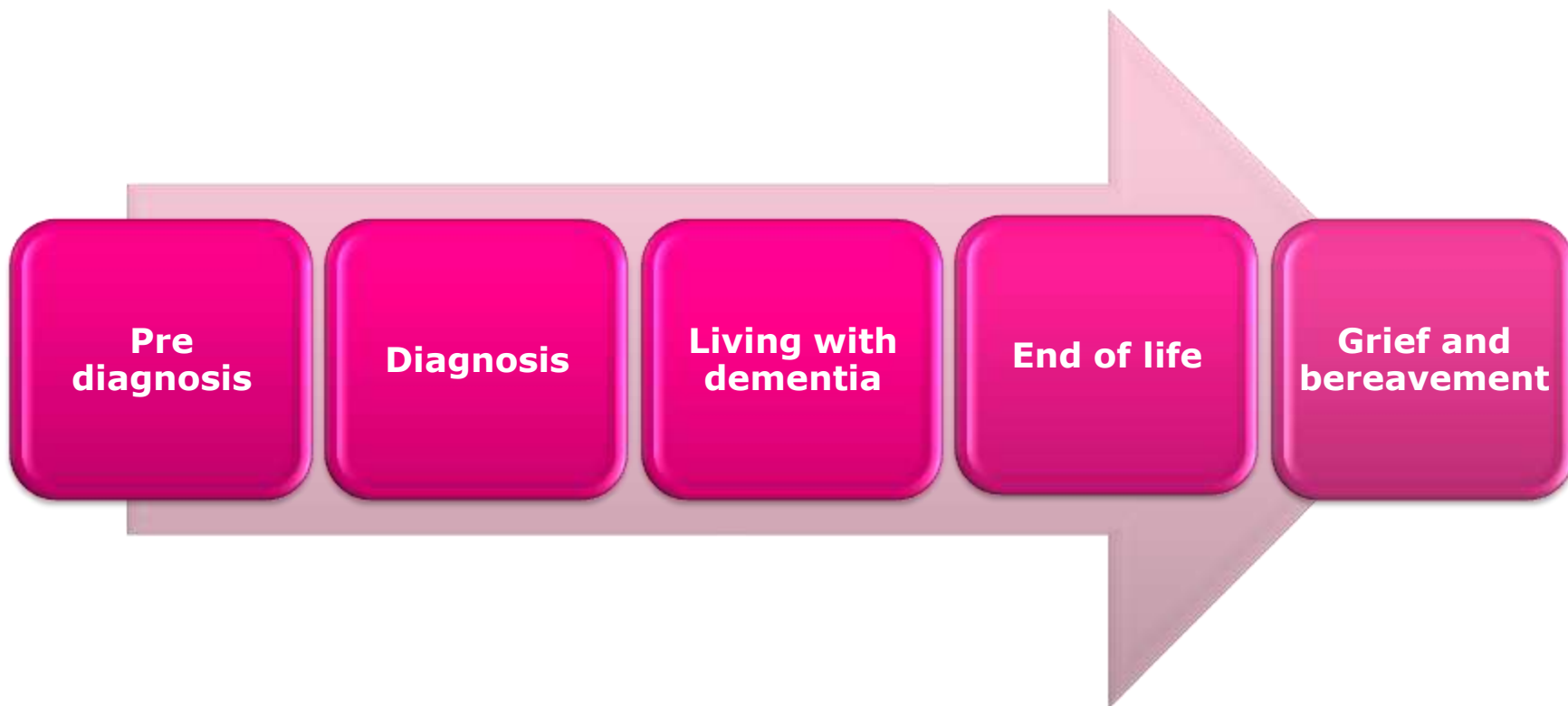

Admiral Nurses: Value for Money

Significant savings to health and social care sectors

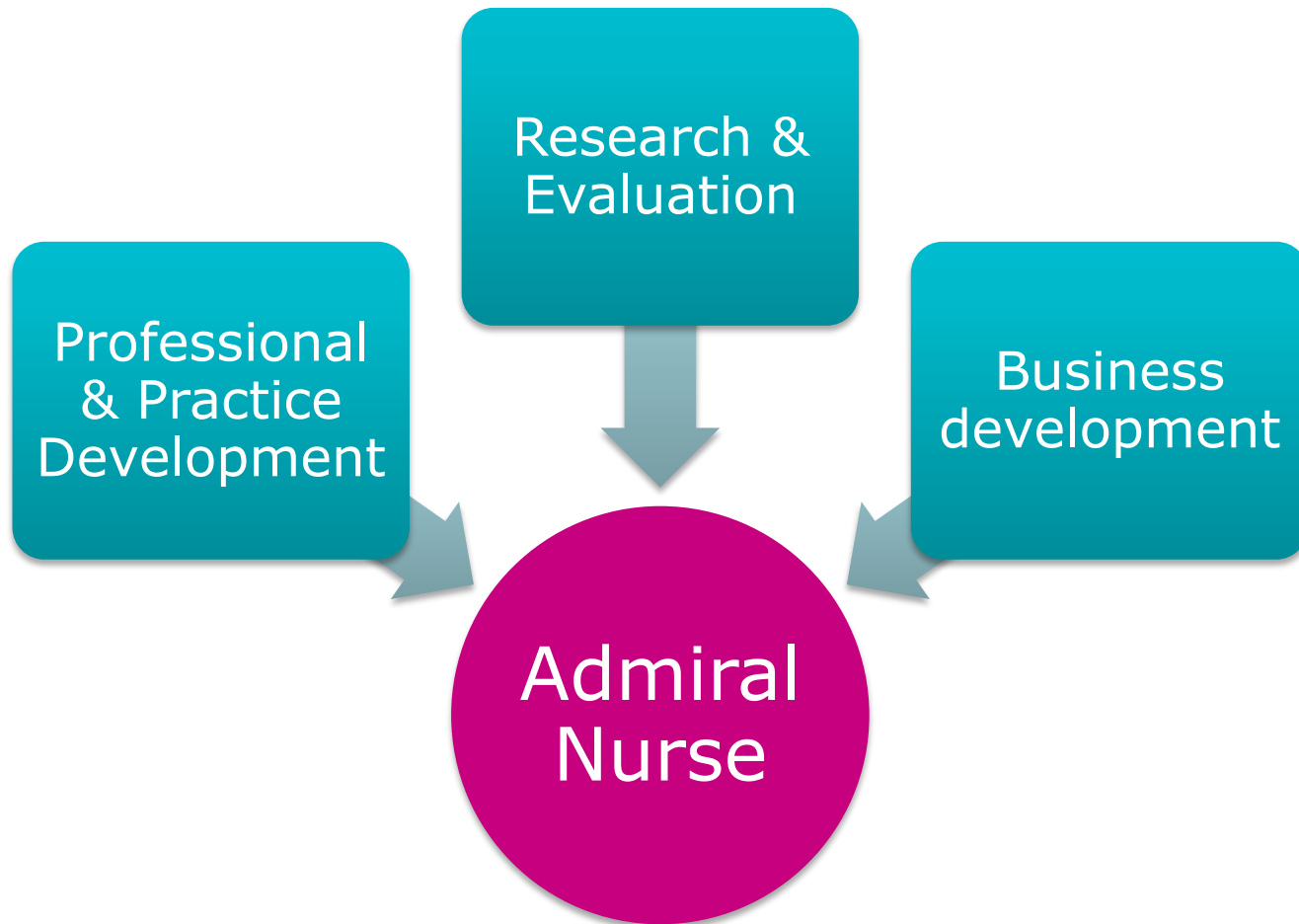
£400,000 saved in Norfolk over 10 months

- Decrease in avoidable admissions to hospital
- Reduction or delay in admissions to care homes
- Increased diagnosis rates
- Increased well-being reported by people living with dementia
- Families felt supported – anxiety and stress reduced

£296,466 saved in Sutton local authority in one year

- Delayed admissions to care and nursing homes
 - Avoided admissions to acute general and A&E
 - Referrals to IAPT avoided
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How Dementia UK Supports Admiral Nurses
