US: Second Chance Act, 2007

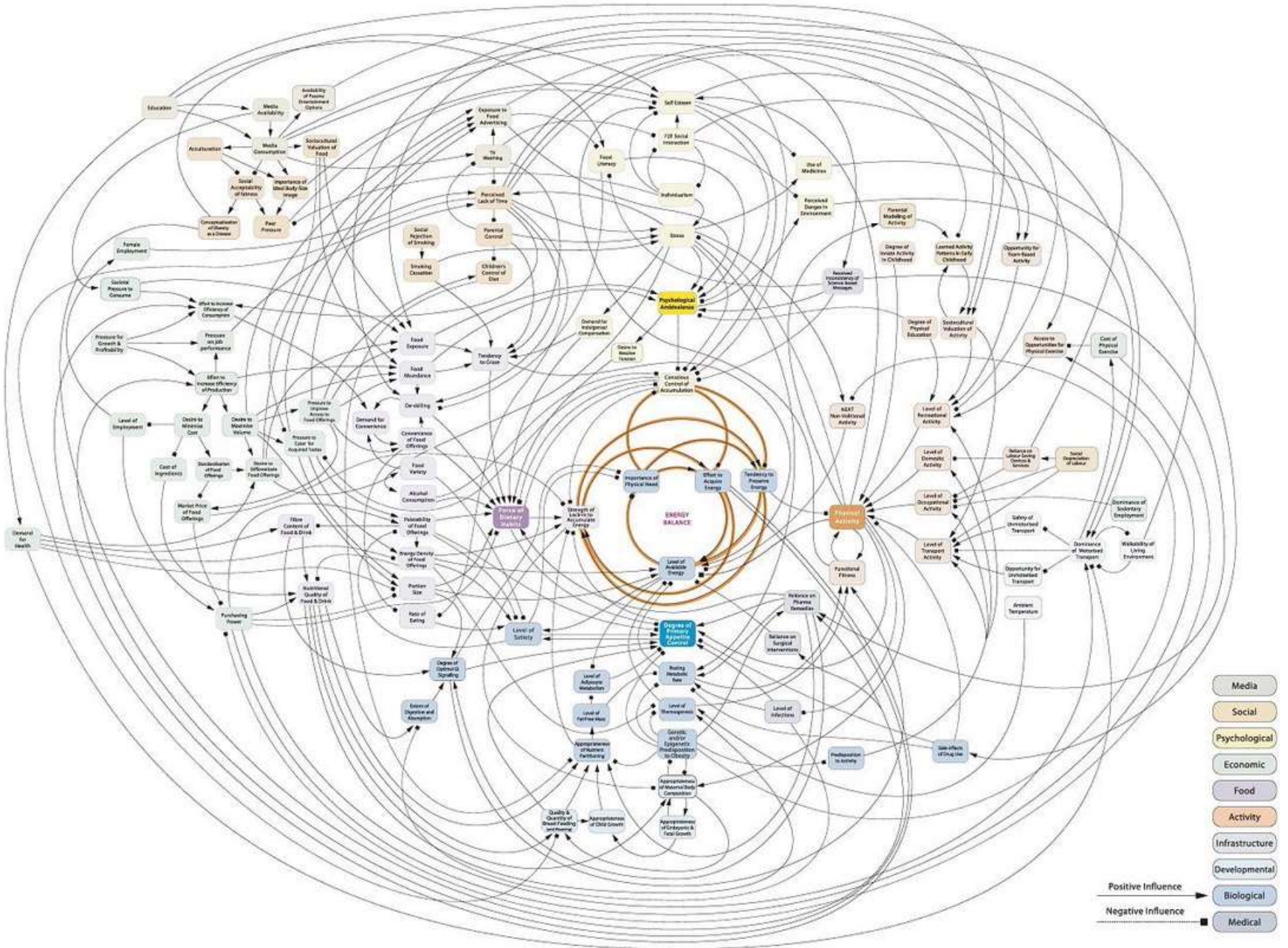
